Learn by watching, by taking pictures, and attending the classes.

How to...

At 9:15am a short, instructional session will be conducted about how to use the studio setups, lighting, and model placement. Immediately following is a session on using the still-life (tabletop) setups. In the afternoon our favorite digital processing guy will have a class on optimizing your images from the workshop.

Film users

We recommend daylight film. ISO 100 is preferred. Tabletop set-ups use 5500 and 6500K lights. We recommend a warning filter for the 6500K lights to reduce the blue cast with daylight film.

Who should come

Anyone with a camera and an interest in photographing tabletop setups and/or people with studio lights will benefit from this friendly, learning day with fellow photographers. If you are really new to this, let us know so you can get some extra attention to get the most out of the day.

Note: To connect to the studio lighting set-ups, your camera needs to have a standard hot shoe. Sony/Minolta users with the narrow hot shoe will need to bring an adapter to make it standard size for our studio setups.
